



Student Contract for Appropriate Use of Online Learning

Acceptable Rules:

1. Raising your hand when you have a question.
2. Waiting to speak until called upon.
3. Talking when asked to speak.
4. Taking turns speaking.

Unacceptable Rules:

1. Interrupting others (peers and teachers) while they are speaking.
2. Using disrespectful language such as vulgarity, swear words, threats of any kind.
3. Disrupting the class by laughing, calling out your classmates' names.
4. Hitting the present button during class unless asked by your teacher.
5. Using your phone when you are in class.
6. Screenshots or taking pictures of others.
7. Playing with toys, objects, etc. that others can see.
8. Making distracting noises that disturb others.

When you are upset or anxious:

1. Remember you can ask for a break just like you do at school (use a timer).
2. Ask your teacher to repeat what they said.
3. Ask your parent/sister/brother for help.

What will happen if you do not follow the rules:

1. Your teacher will give you the warning to stop the distracting behavior.
2. If you stop, you will continue to participate in the class.
3. If you do not stop, your teacher will ask you to take a break for a few minutes.
4. If you take a break, you will be allowed to get back to the classroom.
5. If you refuse to take a break and continue to disrupt the classroom your teacher will block you from the classroom for the rest of the class period.
6. Your parents will be notified if you continue to disrupt the classroom.

What happens if you follow the rules:

1. You get to see Lou.
2. Get a lot of compliments from your teachers/staff.
3. You have a chance to be "student of the week".
4. Your parents will be proud.
